## **Coroner's Inquest Finding**

Sheriff-Coroner David O. Livingston announces that a Coroner's Jury has reached a finding in the August 18, 2019 death of 35-year-old Benito Stefano Carrasco of Clayton. The finding of the jury is that the death is an accident.

The Coroner's Jury reached the 10-0 verdict after hearing the testimony of witnesses called by the hearing officer, Matthew Guichard.

A Coroner's Inquest, which Sheriff-Coroner Livingston convenes in all fatal incidents involving peace officers, is a public hearing during which a jury rules on the manner of a person's death. Jury members can choose from the following four options when making their finding:

Accident Suicide Natural Causes At the hands of another person, other than by accident.
